New Data Compiled from US Vital Statistics* indicate that Home Birth Rates Increased by 77.3% between 2009 and 2014

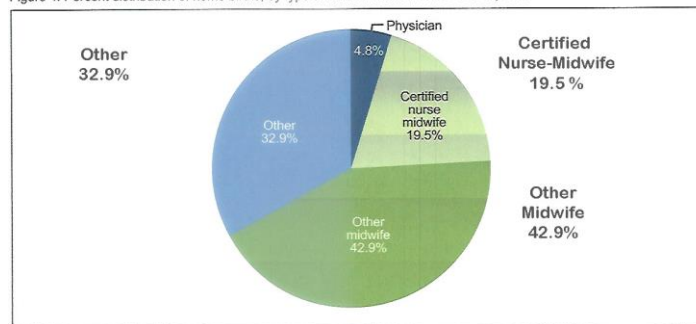
This is such an astonishing rate that a study has been published* suggesting that the Medical Establishment seek the reason for this increase.
